Jubilees 22:8

(RHCV, R.H. Charles Version)

The sword of **the adversary** has not overcome me in all that Thou hast given me and my children all the days of my life until this day.

The Devil

First Peter 5:8-9

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. **Your adversary, the devil,** prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.

James 4:7

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Submit therefore to God. **Resist the devil** and he will flee from you.

Matthew 25:41

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared **for the devil and his angels**;

Matthew 4:1-11

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness **to be tempted by the devil**. And his tail swept away a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And **the dragon** stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child.

Apocalypse of Abraham 23:1-13

(AKT, Alexander Kulik Translation)

Look again at the picture, who is the one who seduced Eve, and what is the fruit of the tree. And you will know what will happen, and how, to your seed among people in the last days of the age. And what you cannot understand, I shall make known to you what was pleasing to me and I shall tell you the things kept in my heart. And I looked at the picture, and my eyes ran to the side of the garden of Eden. (Continued...)

And I saw there a man very great in height and terrible in breadth, incomparable in aspect, entwined with a woman who was also equal to the man in aspect and size. And they were standing under a tree of Eden, and the fruit of the tree was like the appearance of a bunch of grapes of vine. And behind the tree was standing, as it were, **a serpent in form, but having hands and feet like a man,** and wings on its shoulders: six on the right side and six on the left. (Continued...)

And he was holding in his hands the grapes of the tree and feeding the two whom I saw entwined with each other. And

And place upon him rough and jagged rocks, and cover him with darkness, and let him abide there for ever, and cover his face that he may not see light. And heal the earth which the angels have corrupted, and proclaim the healing of the earth, that they may heal the plague, and that all the children of men may not perish through all the secret things that the Watchers have disclosed and have taught their sons. **And the whole earth has been corrupted through the works that were taught by Azazel: to him ascribe all sin.'** And to Gabriel said the Lord: (Continued...)

'Proceed against the bastards and the reprobates, and
against the children of fornication: and destroy [the
children of fornication and] the children of the Watchers
from amongst men [and cause them to go forth]: send
them one against the other that they may destroy each
other in

And **Azazel taught men to make swords**, and knives, and shields, and breastplates, and made known to them the metals of the earth and the art of working them, and bracelets, and ornaments, and the use of antimony, and the beautifying of the eyelids, and all kinds of costly stones, and all

things, and nothing can hide itself from Thee. Thou seest what **Azazel** hath done, **who hath taught all unrighteousness on earth** and revealed the eternal secrets which were (preserved) in heaven, which men were striving to learn: And Semj z , to whom Thou hast given authority to bear rule over his associates.

For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but **against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces** of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

When I have desired to take hold of them by the hand of the angels on the day of tribulation and pain because of this, I will cause My chastisement and My wrath to abide upon them, saith God, the Lord of Spirits. Purpose

John 10:10

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"The thief comes only **to steal and kill and destroy**; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

"And this woman, a daughter of Abraham as she is, **whom Satan has bound for eighteen long years**, should she not have been released from this bond on the Sabbath day?"

Luke 22:31

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"Simon, Simon, behold, **Satan has demanded
permission to sift you** like wheat;

Matthew 13:19

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

People Follow The Adversary

Acts 26:18

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

to open their eyes so **that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God**, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

First John 3:10

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

By this the children of God **and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God**, nor the one who does not love his brother.

First John 3:8

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.
