"And now, behold, I know that all of you, among whom I went about **preaching the kingdom**, will no longer see my face.

Acts 28:23

When they had set a day for Paul, they came to him at his lodging in large numbers; and he was explaining to them by solemnly testifying about **the kingdom of God** and trying to persuade them concerning Jesus, from both the Law of Moses and from the Prophets, from morning until evening.

WHERE DOES ZION COME FROM?

Galatians 4:26

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But **the Jerusalem above** is free; she is our mother.

Hebrews 12:22-29

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel. See to it that you do not refuse Him who is speaking. (Continued...)

For if those did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape who turn away from Him who warns from heaven. And His voice shook the earth then, but now He has promised, saying, "YET ONCE MORE I WILL SHAKE NOT ONLY THE EARTH, BUT ALSO THE HEAVEN." This expression, "Yet once more," denotes the removing of those things which can be shaken, as of created things, so that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. (Continued...)

Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by which we may offer to God an acceptable service with reverence and awe; for our God is a consuming fire.

Revelation 21:10

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, **coming down out of heaven from God,**

Revelation 21:2

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, **coming down out of heaven from God**, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband.

Revelation 3:12

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, **which comes down out of heaven from My God**, and My new name.

For we know that if **the earthly tent which is our house is torn down, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.** For indeed in this house we groan, longing to be clothed with our dwelling from heaven, inasmuch as we, having put it on, will not be found naked. WHEN ZION COMES: THE DAY OF THE LORD

First Thessalonians 4:13-18

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and **remain until the coming of the Lord**, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. (Continued...)

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and **with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.**

Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. Therefore comfort one another with these words.

Isaiah 24:21-23

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

So it will happen in that day, That the LORD will punish the host of heaven on high, And the kings of the earth on earth. They will be gathered together Like prisoners in the dungeon, And will be confined in prison; And after many days they will be punished. Then the moon will be abashed and the sun ashamed, For the LORD of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, And His glory will be before His elders.

Isaiah 27:13

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

It will come about also **in that day that a great trumpet will be blown**, and those who were perishing in the land of Assyria and who were scattered in the land of Egypt will come and worship the LORD in the holy mountain at Jerusalem.

WHAT DOES ZION LOOK LIKE?

Ezekiel 47:6-12

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

He said to me, "Son of man, have you seen this?" Then he brought me back to the bank of the river. Now when I had returned, behold, on the bank of the river there were very many trees on the one side and on the other. Then he said to me, "These waters go out toward the eastern region and go down into the Arabah; then they go toward the sea, being made to flow into the sea, **and the waters of the sea become fresh.** (Continued...)"

"It will come about that every living creature which swarms in every place where the river goes, will live. And there will be very many fish, for these waters go there and the others become fresh; so everything will live where the river goes.

"And it will come about that fishermen will stand beside it; from Engedi to Eneglaim there will be a place for the spreading of nets. Their fish will be according to their kinds, like the fish of the Great Sea, very many.

For you have not come to a mountain that can be touched and to a blazing fire, and to darkness and gloom and whirlwind, and to the blast of a trumpet and the sound of words which sound was such that those who heard begged that no further word be spoken to them. For they could not bear the command, "IF EVEN A BEAST TOUCHES THE MOUNTAIN, IT WILL BE STONED." And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, "I AM FULL OF FEAR and trembling. (Continued...)"

Then you will know that I am the LORD your God, Dwelling in Zion, My holy mountain. So Jerusalem will be holy, And strangers will pass through it no more. And in that day The mountains will drip with **sweet wine**, And the hills will **flow with milk**, And all the brooks of Judah will **flow with water**; (Continued...)

And a spring will go out from the house of the LORD To water the valley of Shittim. Egypt will become a waste, And Edom will become a desolate wilderness, Because of the violence done to the sons of Judah, In whose land they have shed innocent blood. But Judah will be inhabited forever And Jerusalem for all generations. And I will avenge their blood which I have not avenged, For the LORD dwells in Zion.

"In My Father's house are **many dwelling places**; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.

Psalm 48:1

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, In the **city** of
our God, His holy **mountain**.

Psalm 50:2

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Out of Zion, the **perfection of beauty**, God has shone
forth.

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

A mountain of God is **the mountain** of Bashan; A

O people in Zion, inhabitant in Jerusalem, **you will weep no longer**. He will surely be gracious to you at the sound of your cry; when He hears it, He will answer you.

And the ransomed of the LORD will return And come
