YESHUA REIGNS AS KING DURING THE MILLENNIAL REIGN

Daniel 7:13-14

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"I kept looking in the night visions, And behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a Son of Man was coming, And He came up to the Ancient of Days And was presented before Him. **"And to Him was given dominion, Glory and a kingdom,** That all the peoples, nations and men of every language **Might serve Him.** His dominion is an everlasting dominion Which will not pass away; And **His kingdom** is one Which will not be destroyed.

Revelation 20:1-7

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for **a thousand years**; and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until **the thousand years** were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time. (Continued...)

Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for **a thousand years**. The rest of the dead did not come to life until **the thousand years** were completed. (Continued...)

This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a **thousand years**. When **the thousand years** are completed, Satan will be released from his prison,

EATING FOOD

Luke 15:23-30

And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time. (Continued...)

Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. This is the first resurrection. the number of them is like the sand of the seashore. And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
