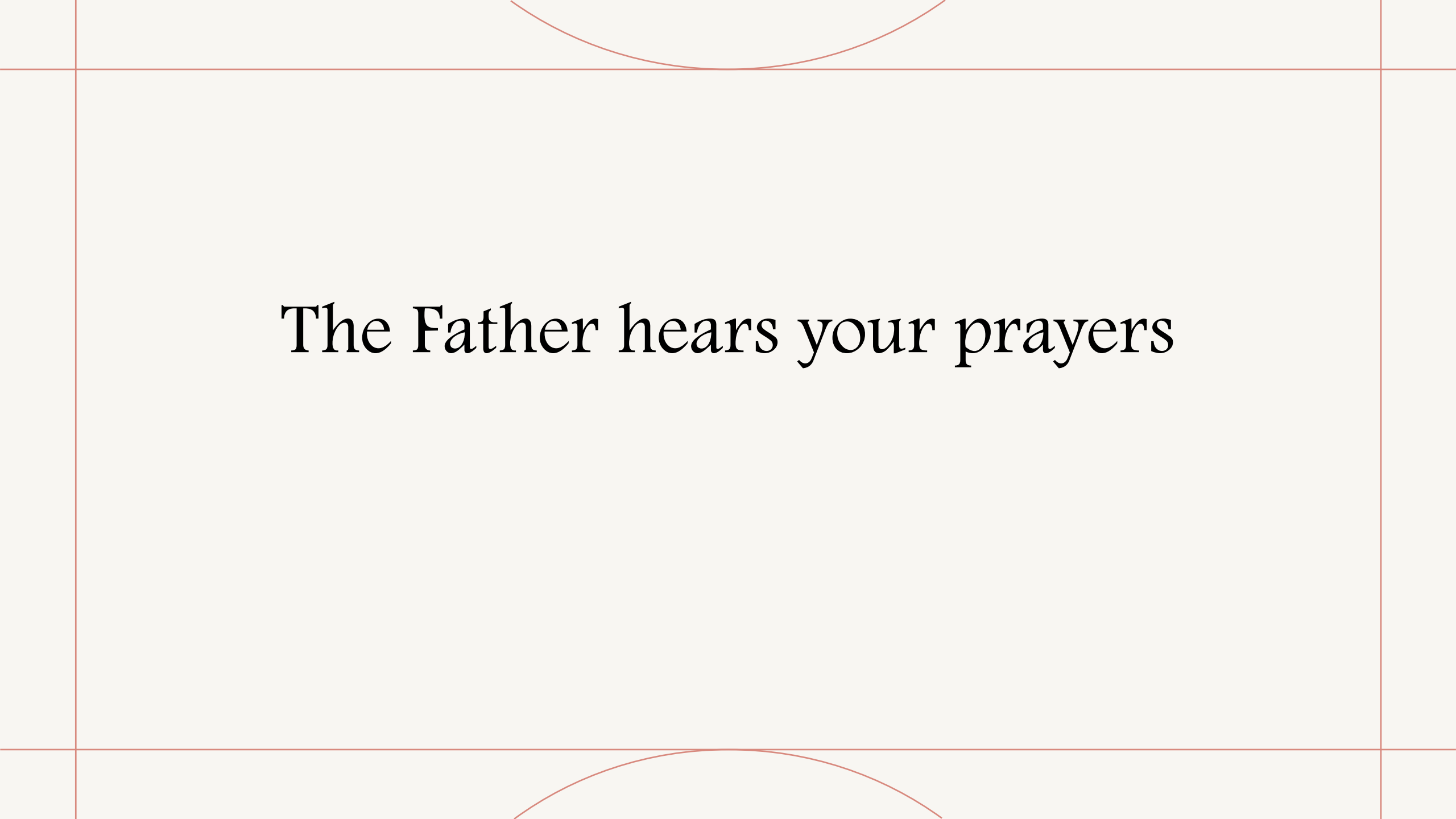

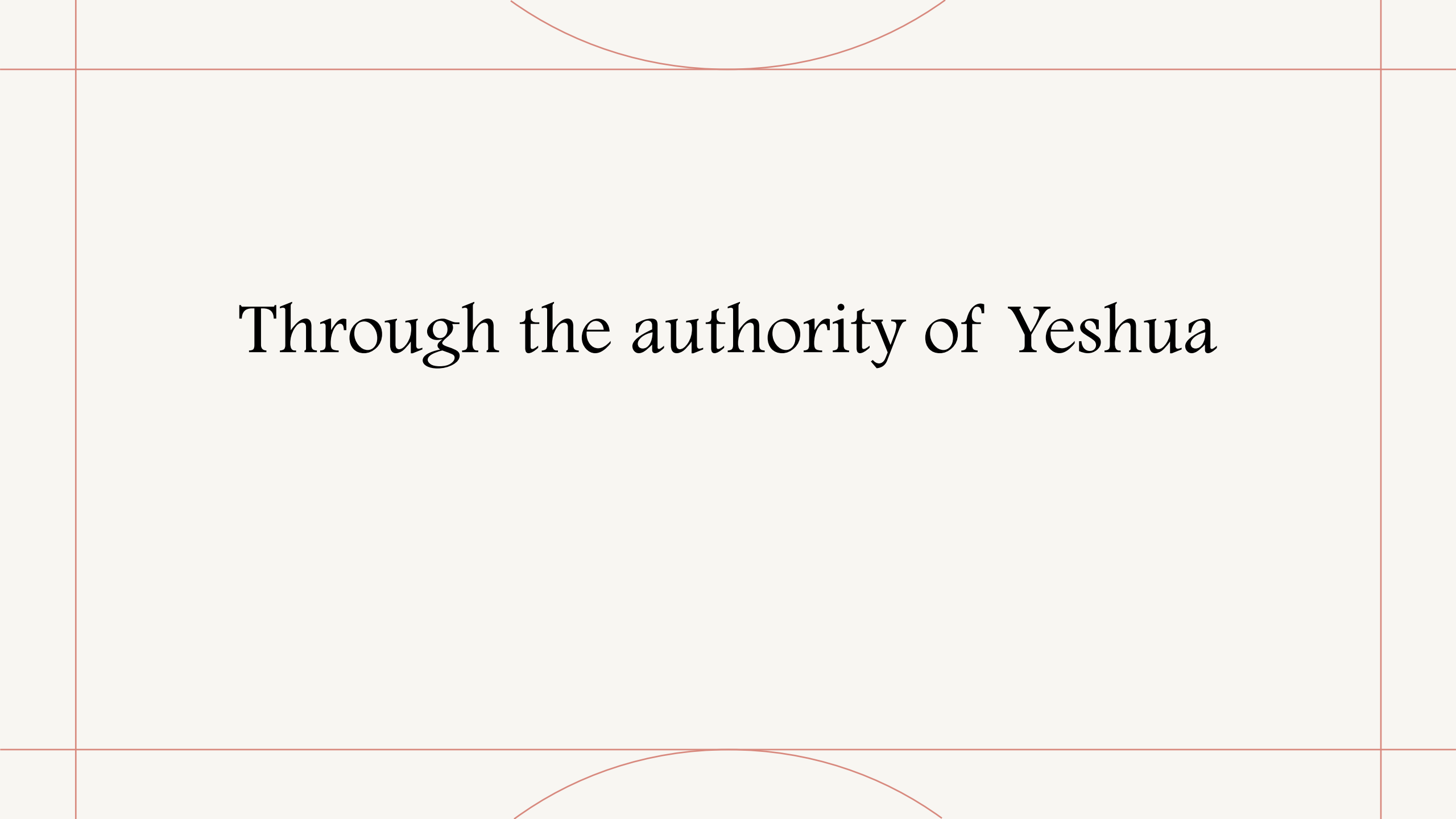

"But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door and **pray to your Father who is in secret**, and your Father who sees what is done **in secret** will reward you.

And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all **filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God** with boldness.

Praying Repeatedly

Matthew 26:36-46

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to His disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be grieved and distressed. Then He said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me." And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me;

yet not as I will, but as You will." And He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "So, you men could not keep watch with Me for one hour? "**Keep watching and praying** that you may not enter into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." He went away again **a second time and prayed**, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done." Again He came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were heavy.

And He left them again, and went away **and prayed a third time**, saying the same thing once more. Then He came to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, the hour is at hand and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners. "Get up, let us be going; behold, the one who betrays Me is at hand!"

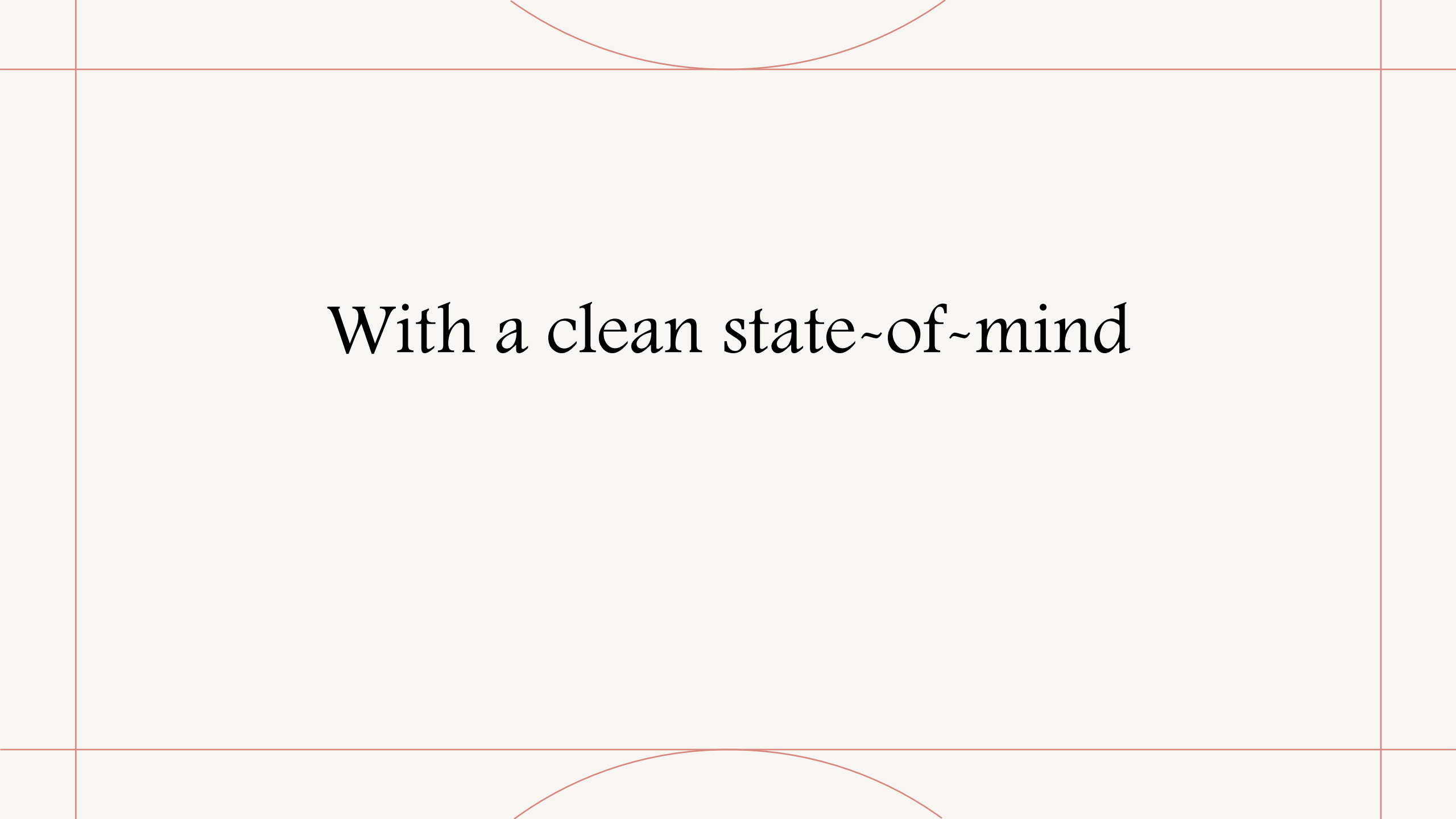
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With forgiveness

Mark 11:25

(ESV, English Standard Version)

And whenever you stand praying, **forgive**, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.



With a clean state-of-mind

First Peter 4:7

(ESV, English Standard Version)

The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and **sober-minded for the sake of your prayers.**

Psalm 19:14

Let the words of my mouth and **the meditation of my heart be acceptable** in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.

This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him and saved him out of **all his troubles.**

Philippians 1:19

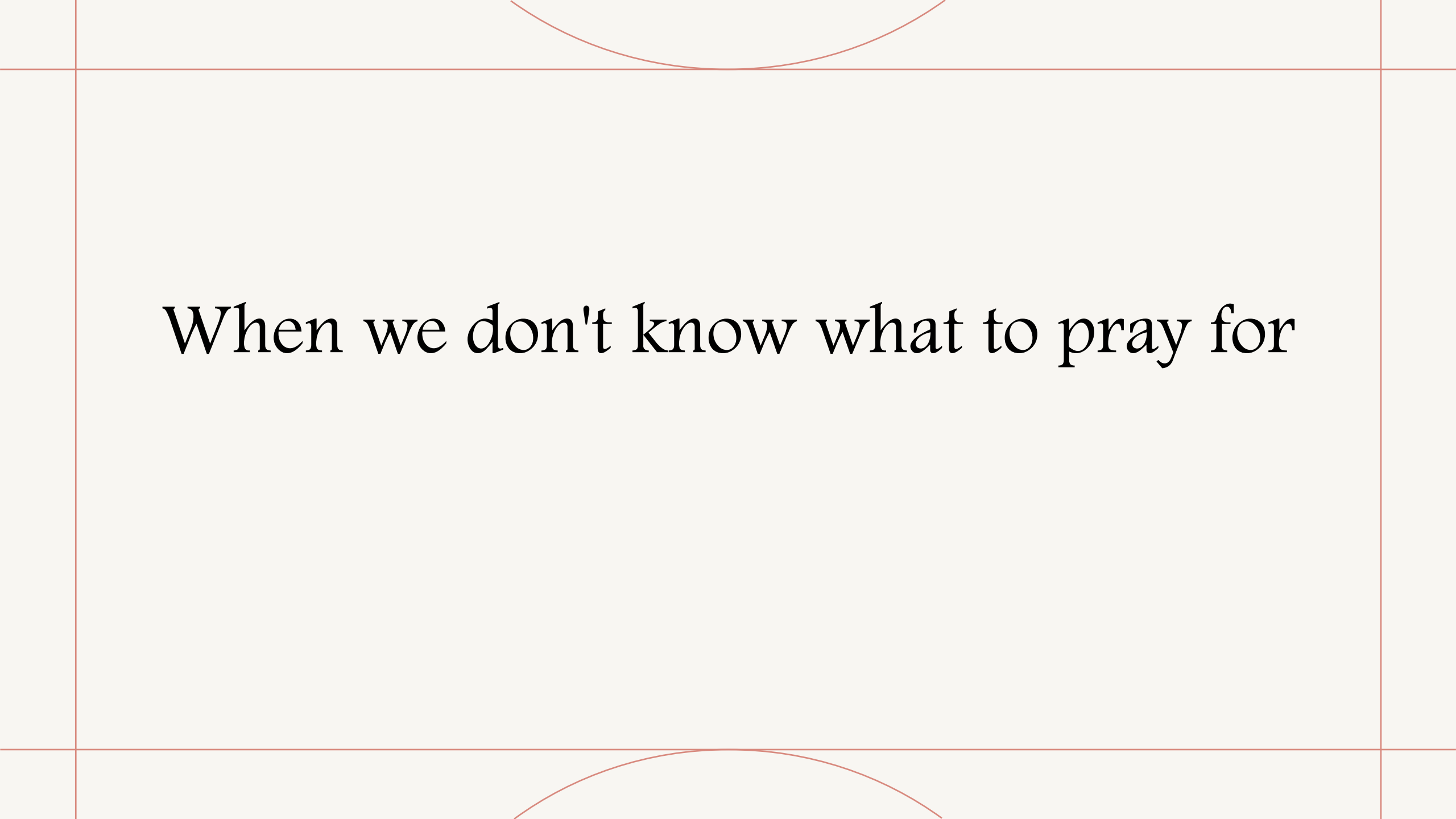
(ESV, English Standard Version)

When we don't know what to pray for

When we don't know what to pray for

Romans 8:26

(ESV, English Standard Version)

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. **For we do not know what to pray for as we ought,** but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.

Three times a day

The Didache 8:1-3

(G.C. Allen Translation)

Let not your fasts be with the hypocrites, for they fast on the second and fifth day of the week; but ye shall fast on the fourth day, and the preparation day. Neither pray ye as the hypocrites, but as the Lord commanded in His Gospel, so pray ye: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so on earth. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debt as we also forgive our debtors. (Continued...)

Three times a day

And bring us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Thine is the power and the glory for ever. Pray thus thrice a day.

At meal time

Acts 27:35

(NIV, New International Version)

After he said this, he took some bread and **gave thanks** to God in front of them all. Then he broke it and began to eat.

Colossians 3:17

(NIV, New International Version)

And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all
in the name of the Lord Jesus, **giving thanks** to God
the Father through him.

First Timothy 4:4-5

(NIV, New International Version)

For everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected **if it is received with thanksgiving**, because it is consecrated by the word of God **and prayer**.

Luke 24:30

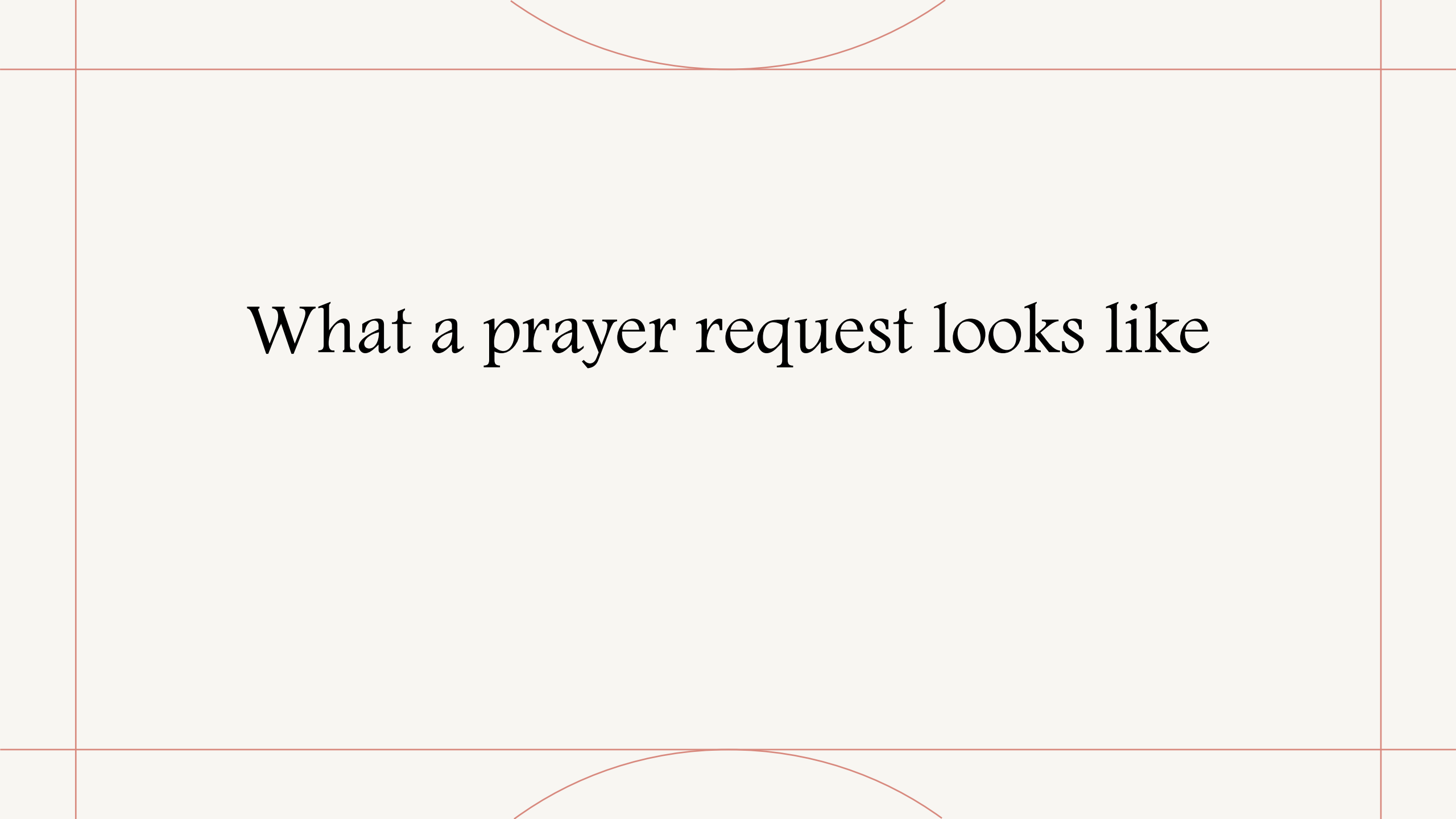
(NIV, New International Version)

When he was at the table with them, he took bread, **gave thanks**, broke it and began to give it to them.

Luke 9:16-17

(ESV, English Standard Version)

And taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven and **said a blessing over them**. Then he broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd. **And they all ate and were satisfied**. And what was left over was picked up, twelve baskets of broken pieces.



What a prayer request looks like

First John 5:13-15

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life. This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, **if we ask** anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

Jeremiah 33:3

(ESV, English Standard Version)

Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

John 14:13-14

(ASV, American Standard Version)

And whatsoever **ye shall ask in my name, that will I do**, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall **ask anything in my name, that will I do**.

John 15:16

(ESV, English Standard Version)

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you **ask the Father in my name,** he may give it to you.

John 15:7

(ESV, English Standard Version)

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, **ask
whatever you wish,** and it will be done for you.

John 16:23-27

(ASV, American Standard Version)

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit **to those who ask him!**

Matthew 18:20

(ESV, English Standard Version)

For where two or three are gathered in my name,

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"**Ask,** and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. I stopped at each of my former encampments until I arrived at Bethel, **the place where I had built the altar**. I then rebuilt it and offered up burnt offering in a meal offering to the Most High God. **There I called on the name of the Lord of the Ages.**

Hearing from YHVH

Visions

Acts 11:4-10

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But Peter began speaking and proceeded to explain to them in orderly sequence, saying, "I was in the city of Joppa praying; and in a trance I saw a vision, an object coming down like a great sheet lowered by four corners from the sky; and it came right down to me, and when I had fixed my gaze on it and was observing it I saw the four-footed animals of the earth and the wild beasts and the crawling creatures and the birds of the air. (Continued...)

"I also heard a voice saying to me, 'Get up, Peter; kill and eat.' "But I said, 'By no means, Lord, for nothing unholy or unclean has ever entered my mouth.' "But a voice from heaven answered a second time, 'What God has cleansed, no longer consider unholy.' "This happened three times, and everything was drawn back up into the sky.

Acts 16:8-10

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

and passing by Mysia, they came down to Troas. **A vision appeared to Paul in the night:** a man of Macedonia was standing and appealing to him, and saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." When he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.

Acts 22:17-21

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"It happened when I returned to Jerusalem and was praying in the temple, that **I fell into a trance, and I saw Him saying to me**, 'Make haste, and get out of Jerusalem quickly, because they will not accept your testimony about Me.' "And I said, 'Lord, they themselves understand that in one synagogue after another I used to imprison and beat those who believed in You. (Continued...)

And when the blood of Your witness Stephen was being shed, I also was standing by approving, and watching out for the coats of those who were slaying him.' "And He said to me, 'Go! For I will send you far away to the Gentiles.'"

Jubilees 44:3-5

(RHCV, R.H. Charles Version)

And while he was thinking of sending word to Joseph to come to him, and that he would not go down, he remained there seven days, **if perchance he could see a vision as to whether he should remain or go down.**

And he celebrated the harvest festival of the first-fruits with old grain, for in all the land of Canaan there was not a handful of seed [in the land], for the famine was over all the beasts and cattle and birds, and also over man. (Continued...)

And on the sixteenth the Lord appeared unto him, and said unto him, 'Jacob, Jacob'; and he said, 'Here am I.' And He said unto him: 'I am the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham and Isaac; fear not to go down into Egypt, for I will there make of thee a great nation I will go down with thee, and I will bring thee up (again), and in this land shalt thou be buried, and Joseph shall put his hands upon thy eyes.'

Daniel 2:23

(ESV, English Standard Version)

To you, O God of my fathers, I give thanks and praise,
for you have given me wisdom and might, **and have
now made known to me what we asked of you,** for
you have made known to us the king's matter.

First Chronicles 4:10

(ESV, English Standard Version)

Jabez called upon the God of Israel, saying, 'Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my border, and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from harm so that it might not bring me pain!' **And God granted what he asked.**

James 5:16-18

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much. Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the earth for three years and six months. **Then he prayed again, and the sky poured rain and the earth produced its fruit.**

Testament of Gad 5:1

(RHCVKJ, R.H. Charles Translation, Edited by Ken Johnson, Th.D.)

God punished me with a disease of the heart. If Jacob, my father, **had not prayed for me, I surely would have died.** The sins of a man are the same things that destroy him.

Galatians 1:11-12

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but **I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.**

Hebrews 3:15

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

while it is said, "TODAY **IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS**, AS WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME."

John 10:25-30

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe; the works that I do in My Father's name, these testify of Me. "But you do not believe because you are not of My sheep. "**My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me**; and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. (Continued...)

"I and the Father are one."

John 10:4-6

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and **the sheep follow him because they know his voice**. "A stranger they simply will not follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers." This figure of speech Jesus spoke to them, but they did not understand what those things were which He had been saying to them.

Testament of Reuben 1:1

(RHCVKJ, R.H. Charles Translation, Edited by Ken Johnson, Th.D.)

For this, God gave me a disease in my loins that lasted seven months. **If Jacob, our father, had not prayed for me, I know I would have died.** I was 30 years old when I sinned in the side of the Lord. And for seven months I was deathly sick, and I repented for seven years, purposing in my heart before the Lord not to drink wine or strong drink, nor eat meat or pleasant food, mourning over my sin. Such a great sin should never be seen in Israel.

Hindered/Unanswered Prayers

Assumption of Moses 11:17

(RHCV, R.H. Charles Version)

If the enemy have but once wrought impiously against their Lord, **they have no advocate to offer prayers on their behalf to the Lord**, as did Moses the great messenger, who every hour day and night had his knees fixed to the earth, praying and looking for help to Him that rules all the world with compassion and righteousness, calling to mind the covenant of the fathers and propitiating the Lord with the oath.'

First Peter 3:7

(ESV, English Standard Version)

Likewise, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel, since they are heirs with you of the grace of life, **so that your prayers may not be hindered.**

Isaiah 55:8-9

(ESV, English Standard Version)

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, **so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.**

James 4:1-6

(ESV, English Standard Version)

What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is the source not your pleasures that wage war in your body's parts? You lust and do not have, so you commit murder. And you are envious and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask with the wrong motives, so that you may spend what you request on your pleasures.

You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? **Therefore whoever wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.** Or do you think that the Scripture says to no purpose, "He jealously desires the Spirit whom He has made to dwell in us"? But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

Jeremiah 29:11

(ESV, English Standard Version)

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord,
plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future
and a hope.

John 8:47

(ASV, American Standard Version)

He that is of God heareth the words of God: **for this cause ye hear them not, because ye are not of God.**

John 9:31

(ASV, American Standard Version)

We know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and **do his will, him he heareth.**

Proverbs 28:9

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

He who turns away his ear from listening to the law,
Even his prayer is an abomination.

Proverbs 3:5-6

(ESV, English Standard Version)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and **do not lean on your own understanding.** In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Romans 8:28

(ESV, English Standard Version)

And we know that for those who love God **all things
work together for good**, for those who are called

Testament of Joseph 2:1

(RHCVKJ, R.H. Charles Translation, Edited by Ken Johnson, Th.D.)

For God is not a man. He cannot be ashamed, afraid, weak, or thrust aside. In every situation, he is there to comfort. **He only departs for a little while to try your soul.**

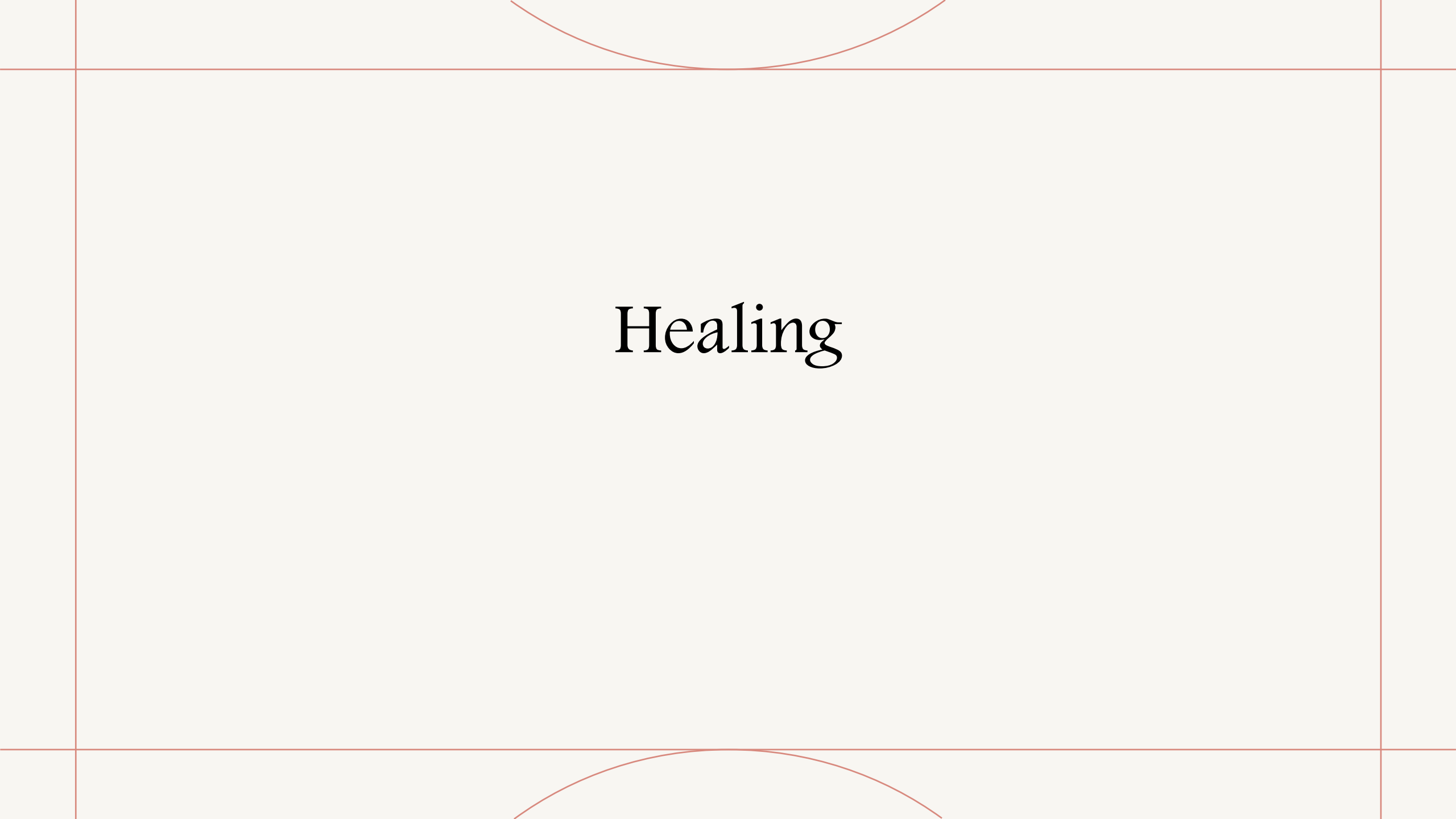
Jubilees 21:22-24

(RHCV, R.H. Charles Version)

Beware, lest thou shouldest walk in their ways And tread in their paths, And sin a sin unto death before the Most High God. Else **He will [hide His face from thee And] give thee back into the hands of thy transgression**, And root thee out of the land, and thy seed likewise from under heaven, And thy name and thy seed shall perish from the whole earth.

Turn away from all their deeds and all their uncleanness, And observe the ordinance of the Most High God, And do His will and be upright in all things.
