And no one takes the honor to himself, but receives it when he is called by God, even as Aaron was. (Continued...)

In the days of His flesh, He offered up both prayers and supplications with loud crying and tears to the One able to save Him from death, and He was heard because of His piety. (Continued...)

Hebrews 7:23-28

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

The former priests, on the one hand, existed in greater numbers because they were prevented by death from continuing, but **Jesus**, on the other hand, because He continues forever, **holds His priesthood permanently.**

Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, **since He always lives to make intercession for them.** (Continued...)

NOW MANKIND HAS A HIGH PRIEST ATONING FOR THEIR SINS IN
THE HEAVENLY TABERNACLE

For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens; who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.

(ASV, American Standard Version)

that upon the Gentiles might come the blessing of Abraham **in Christ Jesus**; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Second Corinthians 5:14-21

(ASV, American Standard Version)

For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that one died for all, therefore all died; and he died for all, that they that live should no longer live unto themselves, but unto him who for their sakes died and rose again. Wherefore we henceforth know no man after the flesh: even though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now we know him so no more. behold, they are become new. But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, **whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior**, so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD, waiting from that time onward UNTIL HIS ENEMIES BE MADE A FOOTSTOOL FOR HIS FEET. For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.

Hebrews 13:11-16

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy place by the high priest as an offering for sin, are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus also, that **He might sanctify the people through His own blood**, suffered outside the gate. So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach. For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come. (Continued...)

Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name. And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

Hebrews 2:8-9

YOU HAVE PUT ALL THINGS IN SUBJECTION UNDER HIS FEET." For in subjecting all things to him, He left nothing that is not subject to him. But now we do not yet see all things subjected to him. But we do see Him who was made for a little while lower than the angels, namely, Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that **by the grace of God He might taste death for everyone.**
