The Spirit gives gifts

First Corinthians 12:4-11

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. **But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.** For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; (Continued...)

to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

First Samuel 19:18-24

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Now David fled and escaped and came to Samuel at Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and stayed in Naioth. It was told Saul, saying, "Behold, David is at Naioth in Ramah." Then Saul sent messengers to take David, but when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, with Samuel standing and presiding over them, **the Spirit of God came upon the messengers of Saul; and they also prophesied.** (Continued...)

When it was told Saul, he sent other messengers, and they also prophesied. So Saul sent messengers again the third time, and they also prophesied. Then he himself went to Ramah and came as far as the large well that is in Secu; and he asked and said, "Where are Samuel and David?" And someone said, "Behold, they are at Naioth in Ramah." He proceeded there to Naioth in Ramah; (Continued...)

and **the Spirit of God came upon him also, so that he went along prophesying continually** until he came to Naioth in Ramah. He also stripped off his clothes, and he too prophesied before Samuel and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Therefore they say, "Is Saul also among the prophets?"

People can receive the Spirit

**Gentiles can receive
the spirit too**

Acts 15:7-9

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth **the Gentiles would hear the word of the gospel and believe.**" And God, who knows the heart, testified to them giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He also did to us; **and He made no distinction between us and them,** cleansing their hearts by faith.

Acts 10:45-47

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because **the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles** also. For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God. Then Peter answered, "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we did, can he?"

"Therefore if **God gave to them the same gift as He gave to us** also after believing in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way? (Continued...)

Gentiles can receive the spirit too

" When they heard this, they quieted down and glorified God, saying, "Well then, **God has granted to the Gentiles also the repentance that leads to life.**"

Numbers 11:25-30

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him; and He took of the Spirit who was upon him and placed Him upon the seventy elders. And when the Spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But they did not do it again. But two men had remained in the camp; the name of one was Eldad and the name of the other Medad. **And the Spirit rested upon them** (now they were among those who had been registered, but had not gone out to the tent), and they prophesied in the camp.

So a young man ran and told Moses and said, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp." Then Joshua the son of Nun, the attendant of Moses from his youth, said, "Moses, my lord, restrain them." Through visions

Revelation 1:10-12

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like the sound of a trumpet, saying, "Write in a book what you see, and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea." Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands;

Revelation 17:3

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness;
and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast, full of
blasphemous names, having seven heads and ten horns.

Revelation 4:2

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Immediately **I was in the Spirit**; and behold, a throne was standing in heaven, and One sitting on the throne.

Acts 13:52

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

And the disciples were continually filled with joy and
with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 19:6

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, **the Holy Spirit came on them**, and they began speaking with tongues and prophesying.

Acts 2:1-21

(ASV, American Standard Version)

And when the day of Pentecost was now come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound as of the rushing of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them tongues parting asunder, like as of fire; and it sat upon each one of them. And **they were all filled with the Holy Spirit**, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Now there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. And when this sound was heard, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speaking in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying, Behold, are not all these that speak Galil ans? And how hear we, every man in our own language wherein we were born? (Continued...)

Parthians and Medes and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, in Jud a and Cappadocia, in Pontus and Asia, in Phrygia and Pamphylia, in Egypt and the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and sojourners from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians, we hear them speaking in our tongues the mighty works of God. And they were all amazed, and were perplexed, saying one to another, What meaneth this? But others mocking said, They are filled with new wine. (Continued...)

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and spake forth unto them, saying, Ye men of Jud a, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and give ear unto my words. For these are not drunken, as ye suppose; seeing it is but the third hour of the day; but this is that which hath been spoken through the prophet Joel: And it shall be in the last days, saith God, I will pour forth of my Spirit upon all flesh:

And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, And
your young men shall see visions, And your old men
shall dream dreams: Yea and on my servants and on my
handmaidens in those days Will I **pour forth of my Spirit;
and they shall prophesy.** And I will show wonders in the
heaven above, And signs on the earth beneath; Blood,
and fire, and vapor of smoke: The sun shall be turned
into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the day
of the Lord come, That great and notable day.

And it shall be, that whosoever shall call on the name of
the Lord shall be saved.
