Is the Law then contrary to the promises of God? May it never be! For if a law had been given which was able to impart life, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law. But the Scripture has shut up everyone under sin, **so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.**

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But before faith came, we were kept in custody under the law, being shut up to the faith which was later to be revealed. Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith. But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. **And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants, heirs according to promise.**

Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has **a great reward**. For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, **you may receive what was promised**. FOR YET IN A VERY LITTLE WHILE, HE WHO IS COMING WILL COME, AND WILL NOT DELAY. BUT MY RIGHTEOUS ONE SHALL LIVE BY FAITH; AND IF HE SHRINKS BACK, MY SOUL HAS NO PLEASURE IN HIM. The Day of Judgment is decisive and displays to all
The Seal Of Truth. Just as now a father does not send
his son, or a son his father, or a master his servant, or
a friend his dearest friend, to be ill or sleep or eat or
be healed in his stead, So no one shall be able to pray
for another on that day, neither shall anyone lay a
burden on another; for then everyone shall bear his
own righteousness or unrighteousness.

Ezekiel 18:21

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"But if the wicked man turns from all his sins which he has committed and **observes all My statutes and practices justice and righteousness, he shall surely live**; he shall not die.

Judged according to works and deeds

Ezekiel 20:11

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

"I gave them My statutes and informed them of My ordinances, by which, **if a man observes them, he will live.**

Judged according to works and deeds

First John 2:17

(ASV, American Standard Version)

And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but
he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

Judged according to works and deeds

First John 3:4

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and **sin is lawlessness.**

First Maccabees 2:51-60

(NABRE, New American Bible Revised Edition)

"Remember the deeds of the ancestors, which they did in their generations, and you will receive great honor and an everlasting name. **Was not Abraham found faithful when tested, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness?** Joseph in the time of his distress **kept the commandment** and became lord of Egypt. Phinehas our ancestor, because he was deeply zealous, received the covenant of everlasting priesthood. Joshua, because he **fulfilled the command**, became a judge in Israel. (Continued...)

Caleb, because he testified in the assembly, received an inheritance in the land. David, because he was merciful, inherited the throne of the kingdom forever. Elijah, because of great zeal for the law, was taken up into heaven. Hananiah, Azariah, and Mishael believed and were saved from the flame. 60 Daniel, because of his innocence, was delivered from the mouth of the lions. Daniel, because of his innocence, was delivered from the mouth of the lions.

James 2:18-26

(NASB, New American Standard Bible)

But someone may well say, "You have faith and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works." You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder. But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless? Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up Isaac his son on the altar? (Continued...)

You see that faith was working with his works, and as a result of the works, faith was perfected; and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS," and he was called the friend of God. **You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone.** In the same way, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way?

For he that lacketh these things is blind, seeing only what is near, having forgotten the cleansing from his old sins. Wherefore, brethren, give the more diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never stumble: for thus **shall be richly supplied unto you the entrance into the eternal kingdom** of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

The first way, because they have scorned the Torah of the Most High. The second way, because they cannot now make a tov repentance that they may live.

The third way, they shall see the reward laid up for those who have trusted the Covenants of the Most High YHVH. The fourth way, they shall consider the torment laid up for themselves in the last day. The fifth way, they shall see how the habitations of the others are guarded by angels in profound quiet. The sixth way, they shall see how some of them will pass over into torments. (Continued...)

The seventh way, which is worse than all the ways that have been mentioned, because they shall utterly waste away in confusion and be consumed with shame, and shall wither with fear at seeing the splendor of the Most High YHVH before whom they sinned while they were alive, and before whom they are to be judged in the last times.
